Lodge Directions GSP North to the NY Thruway (I-87) to Albany Exit 24. Go North on NY Northway (also I-87) to exit 20. Left at the first light (Rt. 149 & 9). Right on Rt. 149 at next light. At intersection 149 & 4, turn Left onto Rt. 4 (signs for Whitehall). Follow Rt. 4 in and out of Rutland. After passing Pico and down steep hill, turn left on Rt. 100 N. Bear left to stay on 100 at 107 split. Make a Left at Stockbridge blinker. Stay on 100 N through curves for .2 miles along the White River, then .75 mi. straight stretch. Lodge is on right.

Organized Drive-Up Trip Rates CJSC Club Members are \$110 per weekend, or \$33 (food cost) if prepaid Lodge Pack nights are used. Guest are \$110 per weekend. This fee includes two nights lodging, Saturday breakfast, appetizers and dinner, and Sunday breakfast. Lift ticket fees are additional; lunches and happy hour are on your own. Plan ahead to have vouchers or lift passes with you. Please read the cancellation policy below before submitting payment.

Guests Members of NJ Ski Council participating clubs are welcome to attend trips. We are always happy to have friends, coworkers & family along as guests as well. A guest must accompany a CJSC member OR be a current member of a NJSSC participating club; both pay the guest rate above.

Drive-Up Trip Cancellation Policy A full refund will be given only if the trip captain is notified AND at least one of the following conditions applies: You give notice of cancellation at least 10 days prior to trip departure (to trip captain) OR The trip is cancelled by the club. A partial refund will be given if cancellation is less than 10 days from trip departure. Trip captains do NOT make decisions on refunds. Refund requests must be in writing to Board (CJSC, PO Box 45, Matawan NJ 07747) for consideration.

Drive-Up Trip Sign-Up Sign-ups are held at regular meetings approximately 1 - 2 weeks prior to each trip. You do not need to be present to sign up; you are always welcome to sign up earlier or call a capt.

- Trips are limited to 38 people and are on a first-come, first on the list basis for members. A reservation must be made by each individual on the Club's website to be confirmed on a Drive-Up Trip.
- Checks preferred at signup, written out to CJSC. Checks mailed to captains must be received promptly to confirm a spot. For in-person signups, sometimes Venmo is accepted.

... an additional note about lift tickets (Trip Captains DO NOT carry discount tickets):

• The club lodge is very close to Killington, Pico and Sugarbush. Stratton, Okemo, Magic, Bromley, Jay Peak and Bolton are all easy drives from the lodge. Plan your ski days and lift tickets ahead of time for the best pricing -- options are NJ Ski Council vouchers (available through the club with 3 weeks advance notice), Ikon or Epic passes, a buddy discount from someone with an Ikon pass, K-Tickets available ahead of the season from Killington, lift ticket packs from Costco, or worst case, buy online a few days before you go.

Packing for a Lodge Visit Pack light for your VT trip – all luggage must be stored under your bunk, and you'll only need casual clothes for the lodge. Include a set of twin sheets, a pillowcase, a towel, pajamas, toiletry items and small flashlight. Leave your skis/board locked in your vehicle. Boot and gear bags can be stowed inside to stay warm. BYOB for beverages, if you have food restricktions, and any medications. Pillows, comforters, coffee and tea are provided. Lodge has internet but no TV. Lodge tap water is awesome.

Open Weekends Prior reservations are required for all Club members when there is not a Drive-Up Trip scheduled. You will need to make an online reservation prior to your visit, and get the lodge door combination from the Reservations Chairperson. Plan ahead -- NO SAME DAY reservations will be granted.
