Same as last year ... If you live in the United States be aware that the border between the United States and Canada has not opened yet, and we do not know if it will be open in January. However, since some of our members do live in Canada, they can take advantage of this group rate without the concern of travel restrictions.

See the flyer for price details. Some things to note about this trip:

- 1. Ski-in/ski-out;
- 2. Prices are Canadian dollars (do the math);
- 3. Additional parking fee of 15\$ per day (think car-pool);
- 4. No pool no hot tub;
- 5. You determine who your condo-mates will be and what size condo you will need;
- 6. You determine how many lift tickets you want for the week;
- 7. You call the Reservation Phone Number on the flyer and give them our Group Coupon Code:
- 8. Reservations are made on an individual basis and will be made according to availability (they are not reserving a block of rooms for our club);
- 9. You make your reservation with your valid credit card to secure your reservation;
- 10. A deposit of one night plus taxes is charged at the time of the booking (calculation based on the average nightly room rate for that particular stay);
- 11. Final payment will be taken 2 days prior to arrival;
- 12. There is no cancellation fee if reservation is cancelled 3 days prior to arrival;
- 13. All cancellations received 2 days or less before the arrival will result on a cancellation fee equivalent to 1 night's accommodation charged on the credit card;
- 14. No shows are considered as a cancellation. The reservation will be cancelled and the amount of the full stay will be charged;
- 15. All date modifications will be considered as a cancellation and treated according to the cancellation policies;
- 16. There is no fee for any unit type change on the same reserved dates;
- 17. Check-in starting at 16h00; Check-out at 11h00 maximum.

The ski area covers 305 hectares (755 acres) and includes 102 ski trails on 4 distinct slopes for skiers and snowboarders of all levels. With over 1,000 snowguns, the ski station is one of the most sophisticated and powerful snowmaking systems in North America.
