Meetings are held at Town & Country Inn, 48 NJ-35, Keyport, NJ on the first and third Wednesday of the month starting at 7 p.m. from October through early April, with social gatherings at local restaurants and bars during the balance of the year; locations vary. Come earlier to order drinks and dinner.

**Lodge Directions** GSP North to the NY Thruway (I-87) to Albany Exit 24. Go North on NY Northway (also I-87) to exit 20. Left at the first light (Rt. 149 & 9). Right on Rt. 149 at next light. At intersection 149 & 4, turn Left onto Rt. 4 (signs for Whitehall). Follow Rt. 4 in and out of Rutland. After passing Pico and down steep hill, turn left on Rt. 100 N. Bear left to stay on 100 at 107 split. Make a Left at Stockbridge blinker. Stay on 100 N through curves for .2 miles along the White River, then .75 mi. straight stretch. Lodge is on right.

**Lodge Use\* Rates (non-bus trip stays per night fee)** Anyone who has purchased pre-paid lodging nights or a pre-paid Lodge Pack may use their stays for any non-bus trip nights, including for drive-up weekends.

**WINTER RATES** in effect November 1st through April 30th

Member \$50 per night    Guest\* \$50 per night    Under 21\* \$25 per night

**SUMMER RATES** (May 1 through October 31st)

Member \$25 per night    Guest\* \$35 per night    Under 21\* \$25 per night

\*Guest must have accompanying club member present and must have submitted a guest waiver in advance of their visit. Reservations must be made in advance with reservations chairperson. The security combination to enter changes often. Payment to be made immediately following stay.

\*\*All trips and pricing subject to change. Mountains subject to change at the Captain and Mother Nature's discretion. Most Central Jersey Ski Club activities and skiing/boarding are, to varying degrees, hazardous. By signing up for a CJSC bus trip, I voluntarily assume all risks involved. CJSC shall not be liable for bodily injury, property damage, loss of personal property, delays or inconveniences sustained by any member or participant in any activity or on any trip arranged for in whole or part by the club. After reading and understanding this release, I hereby agree to participate in a CJSC bus trip as a member or a guest. Note, all guests will need to sign a Guest Waiver before a trip.

**Bus Trip Rates** CJSC Club Members and Under 21 Guests are \$230 per weekend trip. Guest of a Member/NJ Ski Council Guests are \$250 per weekend. This fee includes round trip motococh coach transportation, Friday sandwiches and beverages, Saturday breakfast, appetizers and dinner, and Sunday breakfast. Lift ticket fees are additional; lunches and happy hour are on your own. Please read the cancellation policy below before submitting your check.

**Bus Trip Cancellation Policy** A full refund will be given only if the bus trip captain is notified AND at least one of the following conditions applies: 1. You give notice of cancellation at least 10 days prior to trip departure (to trip captain). 2. A replacement is found. Trip captains assign replacements based on waiting list order. 3. The trip is cancelled by the club. Trip captains do NOT make decisions on refunds. Refund requests must be in writing to Board (CJSC, PO Box 45, Matawan NJ 07747) for consideration.

**Bus Trip Sign-Up** Sign-ups for bus trips are held beginning at 6:30 p.m. before the Wednesday night meeting, approximately 3-4 weeks prior to each trip. You do not need to be present to sign up.

- Trips are limited to 38 people. If more people sign up than the bus/lodge can hold then we go into a defined lottery system. See the CJSC Constitution and By-Laws on the website for more lottery info. If you wish to drive up to the lodge instead of riding the bus, bus trip pricing is still in effect.
- Checks preferred at signup, written out to CJSC (pricing above). Checks mailed to captains must be received promptly to confirm a spot.
- Indicate Old Bridge or Mahwah pick-up on your signup card. Do NOT change your mind without notifying one of the Captains.

**Bus Trip Guests** Members of NJ Ski Council participating clubs are welcome to attend our bus trips. We are always happy to have friends, coworkers & family along as guests as well. Talk to the trip captains if you have questions about guests. A guest must accompany a CJSC member OR be a current member of a NJ Ski Council participating club; both pay the guest rate listed above.

## Bus Trip Pickup Locations

- Old Bridge: St. Ambrose Parish, 96 Throckmorton Lane, Old Bridge, NJ 08857. Look for bus in lot.
- Mahwah Pick-up: Crossroads Sheraton – Arrive by 7:00. Directions: Enter from Rt 17 on Crossroads Blv & Mountainside Ave. Go straight to Stop sign, make right, then first left. Then first or second right (look for skiers) and parked cars.

**Bus Trip Lift Tickets** Captains will collect money for a group or reduced rate lift ticket about two weeks in advance. At signup, please indicate if you already have a lift ticket (via a season pass, Ikon pass...). Cash or electronic payment may be requested so that the Captain can prepay the ski area. Ask the Captains for details.

**Ski, Board and Boot Bags** We strongly recommend that your equipment be in bags made for that purpose. Equipment is piled together under the bus and the bags will help protect your stuff.

**Packing for a Bus Trip** Pack light for your weekend trip – you'll be handling your own luggage, and it's often quite tight in the bays of the bus. Include a set of twin sheets, a pillowcase, a towel, pajamas, toiletry items and small flashlight. You'll only need casual clothes at the lodge.

**Open Weekends** Prior reservations are required for both Lodge & Club members when there is not a bus trip scheduled. You will need to get the lodge door combination from the Reservations Chairperson.
